## 1. On-site registration Process:

- Delegates are kindly requested to collect their name badges at the satellite registration counter located on the ground floor of the CTICC (inside the CTICC entrance opposite the Westin Hotel) on Monday, 18 September. This should be done at least 45 minutes before the scheduled departure time of the respective field excursions.
- Upon returning to the CTICC after the field excursion, delegates are advised to make their way to the main Registration/Hospitality Desk on Level 1. Delegates will receive their congress materials and important information pertaining to the congress.
